Bouley is an avid fan of Microsoft Flight Simulator, but he noticed that a comprehensive tutorial in flying the larger aircraft did not exist for the game. When he first started using the simulator, he, like many other simmers, was frustrated by stalls and crashes when he attempted to fly larger aircraft in

the flight simulator. He decided, after searching for guidance he couldn't find, that a comprehensive guide—from taxiing to the runway, to take-off procedure, to landing procedure, to taxiing to the arrival gate—was needed to guide both the novice and experienced flight simmer. Bouley designed

the visual tutorial so that the simmer could either follow it from beginning to end or could use it simply to master the skills he or she needed help with.

Bouley, was a police officer from Norwich, Connecticut, and a consultant and Coordinator of Safety at a local Connecticut hospital, became interested in Microsoft Flight Simulator while he was taking flying lessons. Bouley had to give up becoming a real pilot after being diagnosed with a disabling disease, so he decided to devote more time to the simulator and to helping other simmers enjoy the experience. With this in mind, Bouley spent the next year and a half writing his visual tutorial. He hopes this tutorial will be beneficial to all Microsoft Flight Simulator enthusiasts who want to learn to fly larger planes.
